THE BRATISLAVA HOT SERENADERS ORCHESTRA

The Bratislava Hot Serenaders Orchestra belongs to the list of the few strictly “early jazz” oriented bands in the world. The band’s 20 enthusiastic musicians have played together without interruption since the formation of the group in season 1991/1992. Their playing adheres to the sound, style, and feel of such orchestra’s as Paul Whiteman, Jean Goldkette, and Duke Ellington, in addition to featuring Czech, Slovak, and other European classic jazz tunes of the period.

The Bratislava hot Serenaders are well established outside of Slovakia. In 1994 the orchestra won the Sidney d’Or Prix at the Grand Festival of Music of 20s and 30s in Saint Raphael, France. They regularly appear in concert, and at festivals both in their home country of Slovakia, and abroad.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

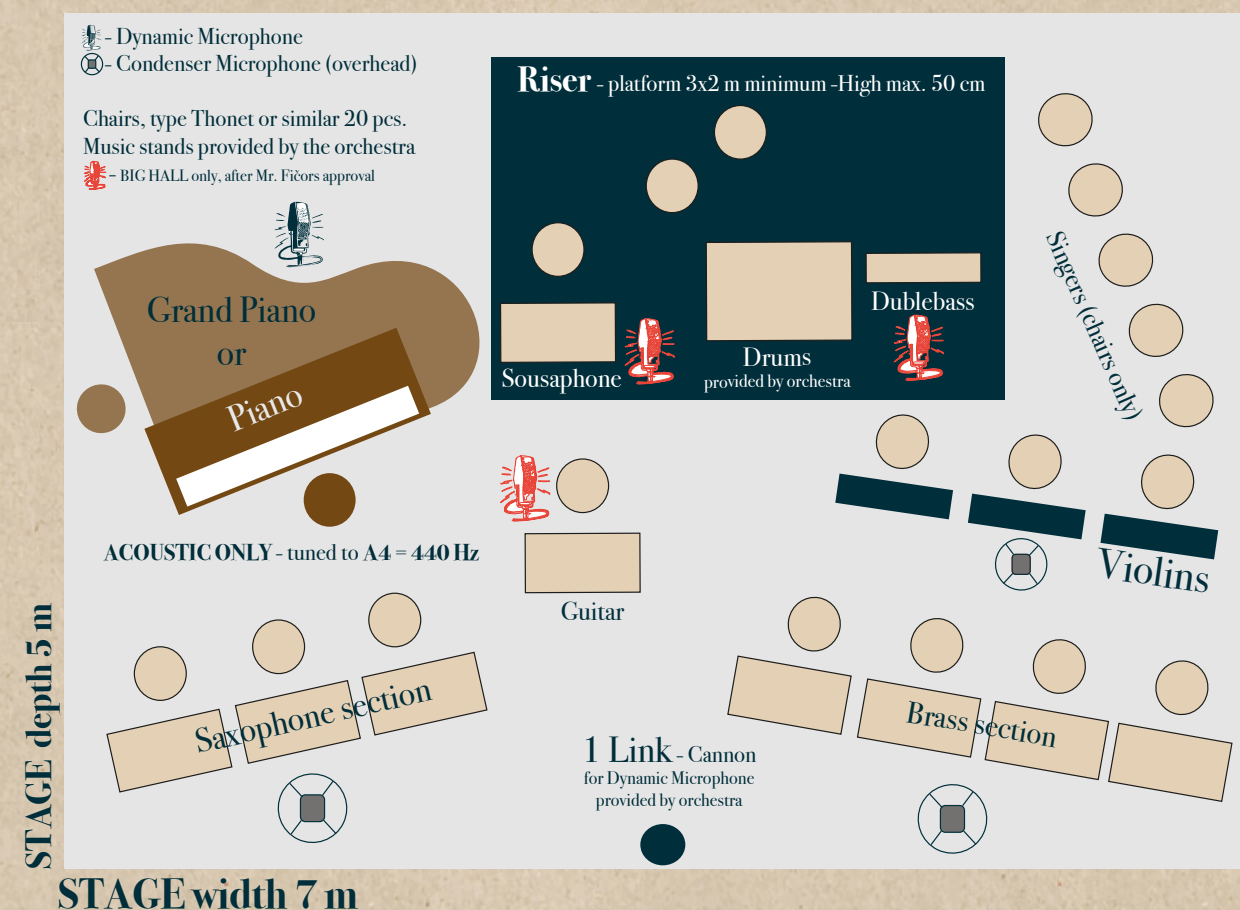
Customers should provide the following at their own expense,
if not otherwise specified by an agreement:

- Stage: raised platform dim: 7 x 5 m orchestra seated as in Stage Plan,
with riser min. dim 3 x 2 m and 50 cm high; or two platforms, dim of 7 x 2,5 m.
- Piano: acoustic only (Upright or Grand), tuned to $a_1 = 440$ Hz.
- Sound: see Stage Plan. Technical sound parameters depend on the acoustics of the place and they have to
meet the requirements given by Mr. Bartos, Mr. Ficor and the sound technician.
20 Chairs without arm rests (best if they are model "Thonet").
Two separate secure dressing rooms (17 male musicians and 3 female performers)

Accommodations:

- Hotel of European standard i.e. 3 stars or better
- Hotel rooms: 10 twins (separate beds), 3 singles (including Sound Eng., and bus drivers)
- Secure room where we can store all of our musical instruments provided and guaranteed by the organizers.
- Hotel safe
- Guarded parking for the tour bus
